What this form is for

Use this form to apply for continuance within Jersey as a Limited Partnership. This information will become publicly available on the register.

Information and required documents you need to complete this form:

- eligible foreign limited partnership name
- proposed name of Jersey Limited Partnership
- jurisdiction of eligible foreign limited partnership and registration number
- Jersey registered office address
- general partner details
- certified copy of the eligible foreign limited partnership's certificate of formation or another document that evidences its formation

 - (d) I confirm that the eligible limited partnership has not been deregistered for a purpose other than continuing as a limited partnership within Jersey.

Pursuant to Regulation 3 of the Regulations:

- (1) (a) I confirm that a certified copy of the eligible limited partnership's certificate of formation, or another document that evidences its formation is attached to this application;
 - (b) (i) I declare that the eligible limited partnership is solvent;
 - I declare that the eligible limited partnership has applied to the JFSC for its consent to the creation of interests under the limited partnership in accordance with Article 10 of the Control of Borrowing (Jersey) Order 1958;
 - (iii) I declare that the eligible limited partnership has applied to the registrar for registration as a limited partnership under the Limited Partnerships (Jersey) Law 1994, and
 - (iv) I declare that the limited partnership will not have legal personality on its continuance within Jersey.
- (2) (a) I confirm that an application to continue has been approved by the general partner;
 - (b) I confirm that if the law of the jurisdiction of the eligible limited partnership requires an authorisation to continue as a limited partnership within Jersey, that the limited partnership has obtained that authorisation.
