Financial Services (Jersey) Law 1998 (**FS(J)L**)

This statement is to warn members of the public against dealing with unauthorised financial service providers.

The JFSC is aware that the scam entity is:

- › falsely claiming to trade from 28 Esplanade, St. Helier, Jersey, JE2 3QA, the genuine registered office address of JTC (Jersey) Limited
- › carrying on, or holding out as carrying on, investment business in Jersey when it is not authorised to do so by the JFSC

The JFSC confirms that:

- › the scam entity, the website and the email address are not associated in any way with JTC (Jersey) Limited
- › the scam entity has never been registered, nor applied for registration, under the FS(J)L, and therefore any investment business carried on by the scam entity is in contravention of Article 7 of the FS(J)L
- › the scam entity, the website, and the email address display warning signs of being set up for fraudulent purposes, and appears to be a scam
